Form 1099 Filing Requirements for: \_\_\_\_\_  
(Company Name)

We want to remind you that **2025 FORMS 1099 NEED TO BE FILED WITH THE IRS BY JANUARY 31st, 2026.**

For all corporations, partnerships, limited liability companies, tax-exempt organizations, sole proprietorships, trusts, and estates (but not for investment real estate rentals), the IRS has made the following questions a part of the tax returns:

- “Did you make any payments that would require you to file Form(s) 1099?”
- “If ‘Yes’, did you or will you file all required Forms 1099?”

If the questions are left blank on the tax return, your tax return will be considered incomplete. **An incomplete tax return has no statute of limitations and is open to an IRS audit forever.** As preparers of your tax return, we are not allowed to answer the questions on your behalf unless you have provided us with the answer. Please take the time to read the **1099 Reporting Requirements**.

- **Year-End QB File with vendor information complete; legal name, EIN and address; or**

- I am required to file Form(s) 1099, and I will prepare and file the forms myself.
- I am not required to file any Form(s) 1099-NEC, 1099-A, 1099-B, 1099-C, 1099-R, 1099-DIV, 1099-INT, 1099-MISC, 1099-NEC, 1042-S, 1095-B or C.

Forms 1099 must be postmarked or e-mailed to your payees and to the IRS by **January 31, 2026**. **The IRS will impose penalties** for missing these deadlines, or for omitting a payee’s tax identification number. If for any reason we are unable to complete any 1099 forms due to lack of timely information, we will not assume any liability for penalties associated with a failure to file.
