Facilities with low staffing on weekends and reported days with no RN coverage are specifically addressed in the memo.

#### 2019 Medicare Part A Coinsurance Rate:

For beneficiaries in skilled nursing facilities, the daily coinsurance for days 21 through 100 of extended care services in a benefit period will be \$170.50 in 2019 (\$167.50 in 2018).
