


Multi-factor Authentication

How it makes your account safer.



Secure your account with double layers of protection.

In the world of technology, multi-factor authentication is one of the best ways to protect your information. A 'factor' is a line of defense that keeps your account safe, it can be something you know (like a password), something you have (like a key-card or cell phone), or something about you (like your fingerprint). Most accounts use a single factor based on a password to secure your information, but as internet security becomes a bigger issue, many accounts are offering an additional layer of protection through multi-factor authentication.

Your online account through Stenseth Samuelson & Boese is now set up for this higher level of security. If you enable the multi-factor authentication in your account, your smart phone or tablet can be used as an additional factor to secure your information. After installing a free Thomson Reuters app on your device, your online account will be able to send a verification request to you whenever you or someone else logs in. You choose to either verify the request, or reject it. This way, if your password is ever compromised, you will be notified if someone else tries to access your account, and they won't be able to get in without your permission.
